Provident Will Help Increase Financial Inclusion In Tijuana

TIJUANA, BC, July 12, 2022.– Provident, a firm that belongs to the English financial group International Personal Finance (IPF) and that in Mexico is the second microfinance institution in the country, will start operations in the city of Tijuana to make available to the population personal loans that are delivered to the homes of their clients, as well as micro-business loans.

Provident's business model stands out because it offers a personalized service directly in the homes of its clients, through independent commission promoters who offer loans mainly in their communities and areas with low access to financial services, with which it seeks to contribute to increase financial inclusion in Mexico.
